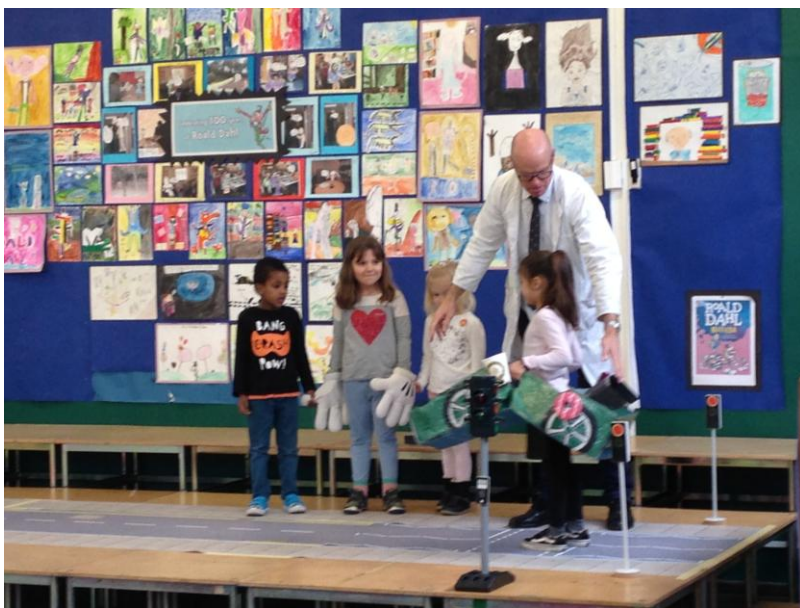
**Some year 2 children said.**
