Newly qualified Early Years teachers from Haringey come to our school every year now to attend training and support from the Early Years provision at our school.

They attend training for the whole day in our school and look at planning, delivery and organisation in the Early Years.

They talk to the staff and children in our Reception classes and observe the teachers and comment on the learning environment.



Melanie Widnall (Principal Advisory Teacher for Early Years Quality in the local authority) said in her evaluation:

"The environments were absolutely full of children's work which reflected their communication and literacy skills.

There are key works and other resources to support their reading and writing.

The Early Learning Goals are clearly reflected and supported in the classrooms. Labelling is clear. Every area was reflected with links made to planning the curriculum.
