Pupil Questionnaires:

Elena Yiapanis our P4C co-ordinator decided to carry out pupil questionnaires with the KS2 children to gain an insight into the impact P4C has had here at MHPS. The positive impact and enjoyment of P4C was clear from the children's responses with the majority stating that they do enjoy their P4C sessions.

In response to the question '*Has P4C helped you in any other subject areas*', a large majority of the children said it has helped them in English as well as other subjects such as art, maths, PSHE and with their communication and social skills.
