Collage Voices: Serious fun in the performing arts for young people from Haringey

I am delighted to be able to tell you about a new provision for young people being set up by Collage Arts, a not-for-profit organisation that has worked closely with the Council over many years to develop and maintain the Cultural Quarter in Wood Green.

Collage Arts is committed to ensuring that young people have access to performing arts opportunities in Haringey and has developed 'Collage Voices'. Starting with a year-round programme of Saturday sessions for young people aged 8-18 years at Collage Artspace 2 (4 Coburg Road, London N22 6UJ), Collage Voices will offer drama, movement and music technology in age appropriate sessions led by a combination of regular tutors and guest artists who are industry professionals.

Collage Voices will be **a safe space where people from across the borough can meet to share stories and experiences** and will create pathways into the cultural industries and support young people to build confidence and develop social skills.

It is crucial that cost is not a barrier to involvement in Collage Voices and 100% and 50% bursaries and sibling discounts are available. Haringey schools can play a major role in ensuring that the bursary scheme – which will be very light touch – is accessed by those families who are most in need.
